

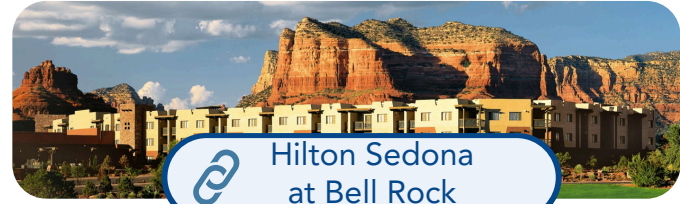

### Night Stargazing Experience

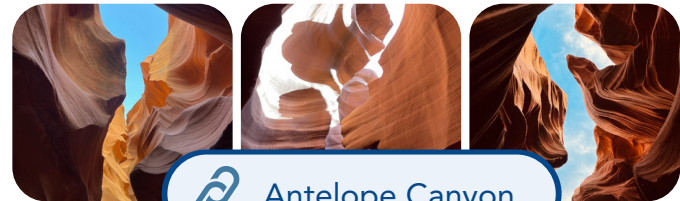
